

Accommodation:

This is a Special Yatra Train consisting entirely of Sleeper Class coaches.

A total of 19 nights will be spent onboard the train.

Accommodation outside the train will be arranged for the following nights:

- 1 night at Kanchipuram
- 1 night at Puri
- 10 nights in Haridwar, Rishikesh, and along the Uttarakhand Char Dham route in the Himalayan region

During these stays, hotel rooms will be provided as per the passenger's ticket class:

- Sleeper Class (Non-AC) Package: Shared hotel rooms for 4 persons.
 Rooms may be Non-AC or AC, depending on availability.
- 3-Tier AC Package: Twin sharing AC hotel rooms (2 persons per room).
- 2-Tier and 1st Class AC Package: Premium-category hotel rooms selected for quality and comfort.

All accommodations are carefully selected to ensure comfort, hygiene, and convenient access to pilgrimage sites.



To maintain cleanliness and hygiene in every train coach and its toilets, two dedicated housekeeping staff will be assigned to each coach throughout the journey.









- Each train coach is equipped with two modern Indian/Western-style toilets.
- Toilets, and cloth washing/drying facilities will be available at the Katha venue.
- Laundry service will be provided at a reasonable extra cost.



Transportation & Entry Tickets Included

All local transportation and entry tickets to temples, heritage sites, and sightseeing locations are fully included in your Yatra package. To ensure comfort, time efficiency, and seamless access at each destination, we have arranged vehicles based on ticket class and journey requirements:

• Short-Distance Travel (Up to 10 km): Hatchback cars, taxi cabs, auto-rickshaws, or e-rickshaws will be used for narrow streets, crowded areas, or very short routes — bringing you as close as possible to the temple or monument entrance.

Long-Distance Road Journeys:

- 1st AC & 2-Tier AC Packages: 5 to 7-seater SUV cars for maximum comfort and flexibility.
- 3-Tier AC Package: 12 to 17-seater LCV vans or mini AC buses.
- Sleeper Class Package: Standard buses (AC or non-AC depending) on location and weather).

Other Inclusions:

Boating rides, ferry transfers, and all entry tickets to temples and sightseeing locations are pre-arranged.

You will not have to wait in queues for ticketing at any place, everything is pre-booked for a smooth and hassle-free experience.



To ensure smooth communication and a hassle-free journey, one dedicated group leader will accompany every 20–22 yatris to guide and assist them at all times.

Arrangements for Kedarnath

Kedarnath is one of the holiest and most significant temples in the Char Dham Yatra. The final stretch of the journey to the temple around 14 to 16 kilometers cannot be covered by vehicles and requires one of the following five available travel methods:



1. Walking / Trekking (Distance: 14–16 km)

- Recommended For: Physically fit yatris
- Religious Significance: Considered the most traditional and spiritually rewarding way to reach Kedarnath

Note: Proper footwear and gradual pacing is advised. Medical checkups will be done prior to trekking.

2. Pony (Horse Ride)

Ideal For: Yatris weighing up to 70–80 kg

• Comfort Level: Moderate

 Estimated Cost: ₹5,500 (approx., including service charges and transfer)

Note: Suitable for those who are not fit for trekking but prefer an economical alternative.





3. Porter (Pithu / Bag Carrier)

Ideal For: Individuals weighing up to 60–70 kg

Comfort Level: Basic, suitable for light-weight passengers or elderly persons

Estimated Cost: ₹7,500 (approx., all inclusive)

Note: A single porter will carry the yatri on their back in a secure seating setup.

Arrangements for Kedarnath

4. Palkhi (Carried by Four Men on Shoulder)

Recommended For: Maximum comfort and safety, especially those weighing 80 kg and above or with health concerns

Estimated Cost: ₹12,000 (approx., all inclusive)

Comfort Level: High

Note: Offers relaxed travel, suitable for elderly or those with medical limitations.





5. Helicopter Service (Not Recommended as Primary Option)

Estimated Cost: ₹11,500–12,000 (may vary depending on helipad and conditions)

Capacity & Availability: Limited seats (max 200 yatris/day across 4 helipads)

Frequent cancellations due to unpredictable weather

Long waiting hours due to overbooking

Our Recommendation

Helicopters often face delays and cancellations. Use only if time-bound. For most yatris, pony, palkhi, or trekking are more reliable and meaningful.

Our Support

We arrange all options based on your health and preference, with full support for booking and coordination.

Note

Helicopter seats are limited and not guaranteed. Ground travel is safer and more dependable for timely darshan.



Healthcare and Medical Aid

- A team of experienced doctors and nursing staff will be available onboard the train throughout the journey.
- Essential medicines and first-aid support will be provided at all times.
- For 2-Tier and 1st Class AC passengers, doctors will conduct daily personal health check-ins to help maintain stable health during the journey.
- To ensure proper hydration, purified drinking water will be provided by the Yatra team for all passengers throughout the journey.

Safty & Security

- Two trained security guards will be stationed in each coach to ensure round-the-clock security for passengers and their belongings.
- Coordination with local authorities and railway security teams will be maintained wherever necessary.





Yatra Amenity Kit

Each yatri will receive a specially prepared Yatra Amenity Kit, which includes:

- A water bottle
- A full travel toiletry set: toothbrush, toothpaste, tongue cleaner, soap, shampoo, lotion, balm, etc.
- Bedding essentials: pillow, blanket, and bedsheet
- A raincoat (for unpredictable weather)
- Headwear cap for men (for sun protection) and dupatta for women.

Linen Replacement Policy

- For AC Class passengers: Bedsheet and pillow cover will be replaced daily
- For Non-AC (Sleeper Class) passengers: Bedsheet and pillow cover will be replaced every 4th day for cleanliness and comfort.

Refund & Cancellation Policy

- If the Yatra is cancelled by the organizers for any reason, a 100% refund will be issued to all registered participants.
- Cancellations by participants will not be accepted after 30th June.
 However, in case you are unable to join, you may transfer your seat to a
 family member, relative, or friend without any extra charge (with prior
 approval).
- If any part of the Yatra program is disrupted or cancelled from our side during the journey, we will make every effort to offer an alternative Yatra experience within the planned dates and route.




